Marcile was one of the founders of the Volunteers Clearing House, a nonprofit organization created to organize volunteers that became a thriving educational center in the Three Colonies, at the time a low-income Hispanic settlement. She was also instrumental in developing the United Day Care Center and the Women's Center here. The City of Fort Collins Women's Commission established an award in her honor to recognize people who have helped improve the quality of life in the community.
